
Dear Parents,

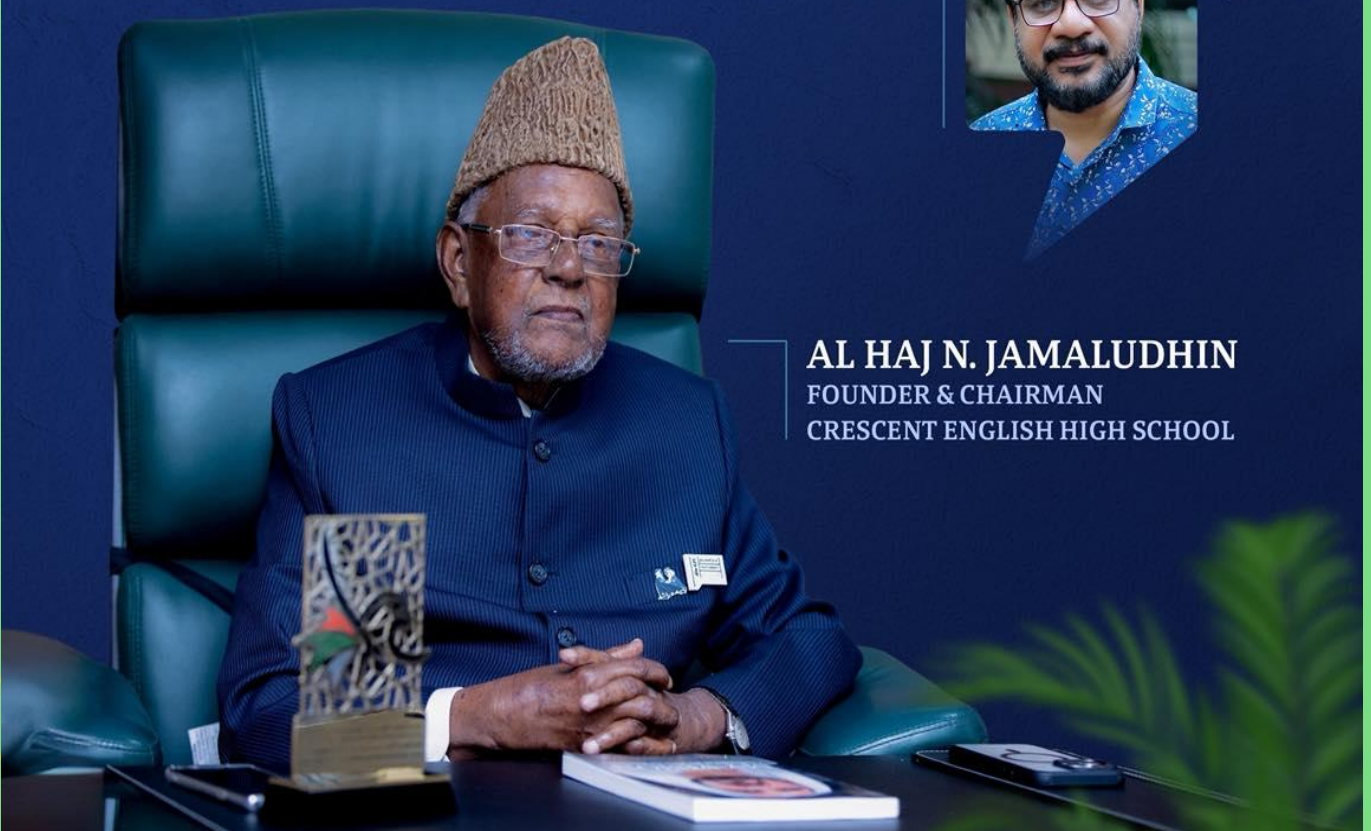
Today, Crescent proudly carries forward this vision—honouring a journey that continues to inspire hope, purpose, and excellence in education.

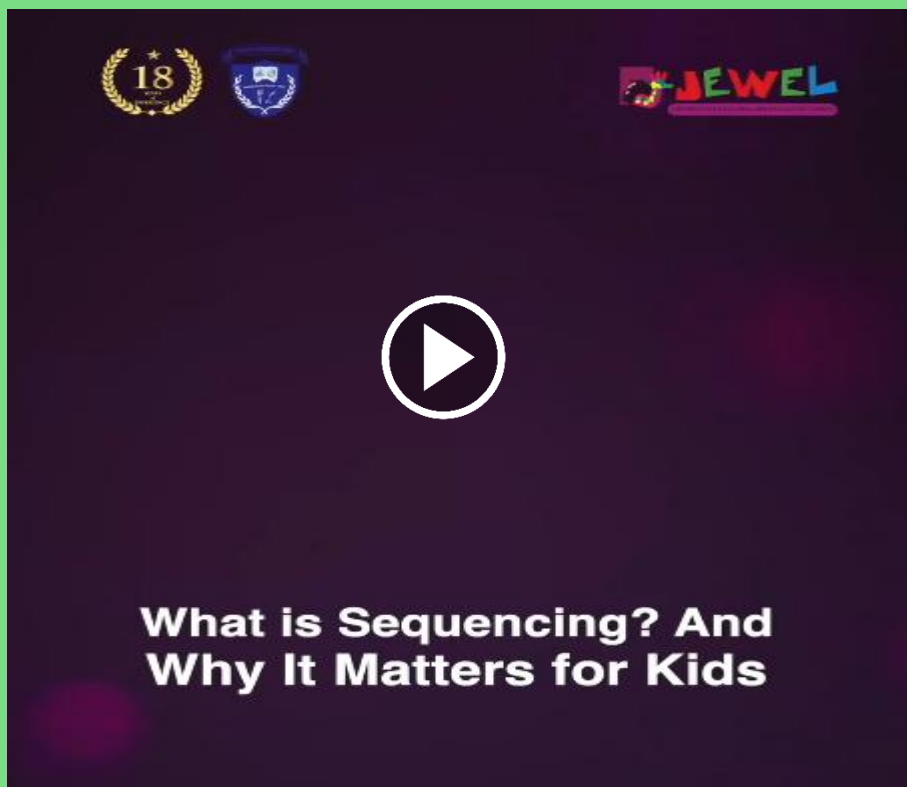
# Sequencing & its Importance: A Parents Awareness Series!
