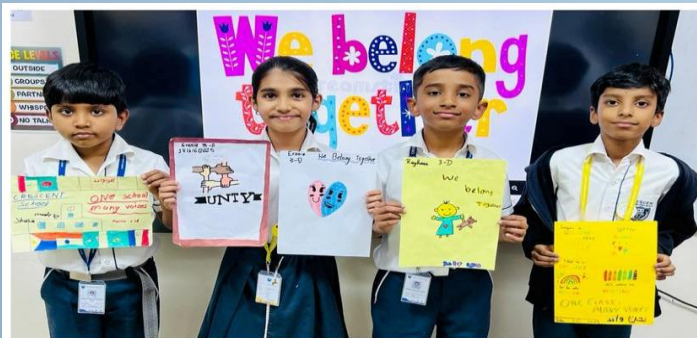

These vibrant contributions showcased the spirit of inclusivity that defines our school community—reminding us that we are truly One School, Many Stories, where every student has a place and every voice matters.



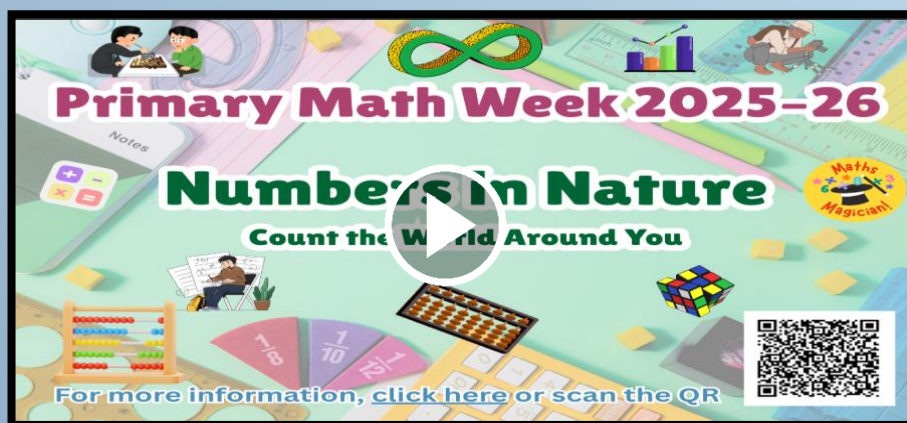
World Environment Day 2025 at CEHS

The week-long celebration provided students with opportunities to showcase their creativity, imagination, and love for literature through a variety of engaging competitions and activities.

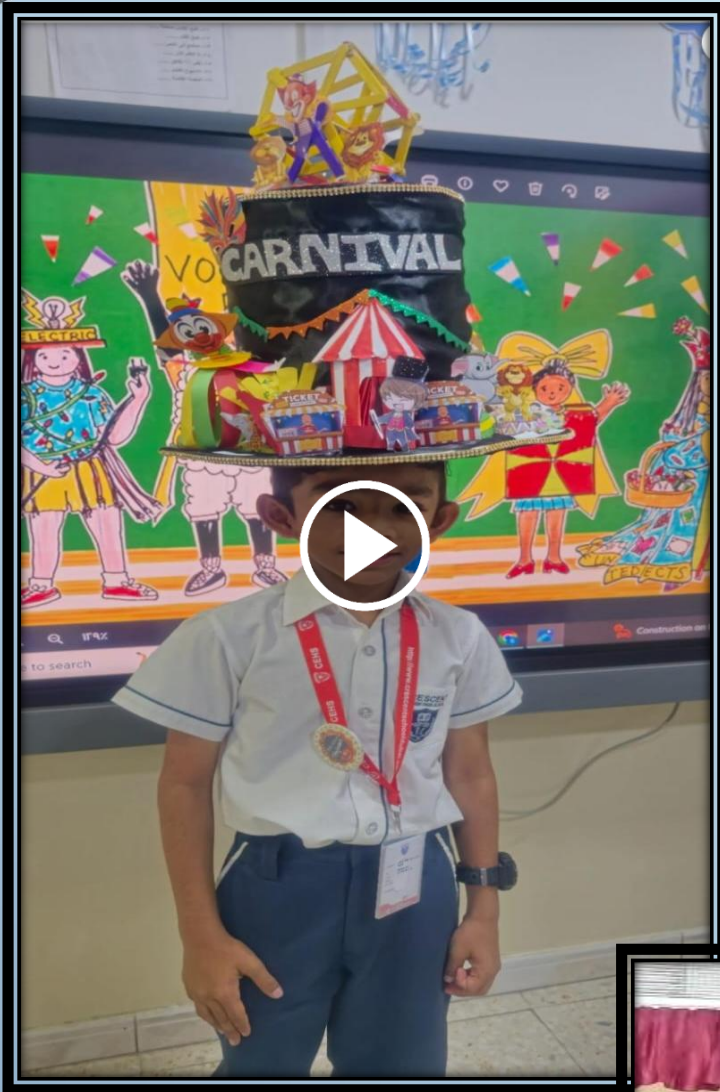
